**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 369-2016**

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Dyer Lane, Redrocket Lane and Smith Gemmell Lane.**

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XVIII (One-Way Highways) in § 950-1317, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Times and/or Days)	(From Column 4 Direction)
Lane first east of Sherbourne Street	Bloor Street East and Howard Street	Anytime	Southbound
Lane first north of Gerrard Street East	Nasmith Avenue and Sumach Street	Anytime	Eastbound
Lane first west of River Street	Gerrard Street East and Spruce Street	Anytime	Northbound

B. By inserting in Schedule XVIII (One-Way Highways) in § 950-1317, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Times and/or Days)	(In Column 4 Direction)
Dyer Lane	Gerrard Street East and Spruce Street	Anytime	Northbound
Redrocket Lane	Howard Street and Bloor Street East	Anytime	Southbound
Smith Gemmell Lane	Nasmith Avenue and Sumach Street	Anytime	Eastbound

C. By deleting from Schedule XXIX (Restricted Width of Vehicles on Highways) in § 950-1328, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Maximum Vehicle Width (metres))
Lane first west of River Street	Gerrard Street East and Spruce Street	2

D. By inserting in Schedule XXIX (Restricted Width of Vehicles on Highways) in § 950-1328, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Maximum Vehicle Width (metres))
Dyer Lane	Gerrard Street East and Spruce Street	2
