BY-LAW No. 501-2016

To authorize the alteration of Major Street between College Street and Ulster Street by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Major Street between College Street and Ulster Street was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Major Street;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Major Street between College Street and Ulster Street by the installation of five speed humps as shown on Drawing No. 421G-1965 dated November, 2015 attached to this By-law is authorized.
