#### **CITY OF TORONTO**

#### BY-LAW No. 752-2016

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 441, Fees and Charges, Chapter 841, Waste Collection, Commercial Properties and Chapter 844, Waste Collection, Residential Properties to clarify certain fees and implement a new Green Bin fee on Solid Waste Management Services customers and to update certain rebates.

Whereas City Council seeks to clarify that Solid Waste Management Services Division waste collection customers, other than residential curbside collection customers, mixed residential/commercial properties, and eligible non-residential properties (specifically Charities, Institutions and Religious Organizations ("CIROs")) properties need to pay an acquisition fee for any organic, garbage or recycling bin that such customers order from the City, at the rates indicated below; and

Whereas City Council has authorized Solid Waste Management Services Division to charge its waste collection customers, other than residential curbside collection customers, mixed residential/commercial properties, and eligible non-residential properties (specifically CIROS) an acquisition fee for any new Green Bin that such customers order from the City, at the rate indicated below; and

Whereas City Council has authorized certain adjustments to the annual residential rebates in City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 841 and Chapter 844;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. The following reference numbers in the first column of Schedule 1 of Appendix A to Chapter 441, Fees and Charges, are renumbered as follows:
  - A. 61 renumbered to 61.1
  - B. 91 renumbered to 91.1
  - C. 100 renumbered to 100.1

- **3.** Chapter 841, Waste Collection, Commercial Properties, is amended as follows:
  - A. Add § 841-6H, as follows:

Owners receiving waste collection services pursuant to this chapter, other than mixed residential/commercial properties and eligible non-residential properties, as those terms are defined in § 841-1, who require any organics, garbage, or recycling bins shall obtain and pay for such bins from the City at the rate set out in Schedule 1 of Appendix A of Chapter 441, Fees and Charges.

B. Delete § 841-6.2 in its entirety and replace it with the following:

#### § 841-6.2. Mixed residential/commercial property collection rebates.

- A. The City shall rebate to an owner of a mixed residential/commercial property who receives collection services the annual amounts indicated in Schedule G in the form of a credit on the utility bill issued under Article III of Chapter 849, Water and Sewage Services and Utility Bill.
- B. The rebate amount in Subsection A shall be prorated based on the appropriate billing frequency as set out in § 849-30 of Chapter 849, Water and Sewage Services and Utility Bill, to reflect the appropriate portion of a full-year rebate amount.
- C. If the rebate in Subsection A represents a credit on the utility bill as set out in Article III of Chapter 849, Water and Sewer Services and Utility Bill, the credit shall be applied to any applicable fees related to water and sewage services that appear on the utility bill in accordance with Chapter 849, Water and Sewage Services and Utility Bill.
- C. Append to Chapter 841 as Schedule G the attached schedule to this by-law identified as Schedule 841-1.
- **4.** Chapter 844, Waste Collection, Residential Properties, is amended as follows:
  - A. Add § 844-29.1, as follows:

### § 844-29.1. Bin fees.

Owners receiving waste collection services pursuant to this chapter, other than those receiving residential curbside collection, as that term is defined in § 844-1, who require an organics, garbage, or recycling bin shall obtain and pay for such

bins from the City at the rate set out in Schedule 1 of Appendix A of Chapter 441, Fees and Charges.

B. Delete § 844-30 in its entirety and replace it with the following:

### § 844-30. Annual garbage rebates.

- A. The City shall rebate to an owner of a residential property who receives residential curbside collection the annual amounts indicated in Schedule D in the form of a credit on the utility bill issued under Article III of Chapter 849, Water and Sewage Services and Utility Bill.
- B. The City shall rebate to an owner of a residential property which receives residential front-end collection the annual amounts indicated in Schedule D in the form of a credit on the utility bill issued under Article III of Chapter 849, Water and Sewage Services and Utility Bill.
- C. The City shall rebate to an owner of a subscription property who receives residential curbside collection the annual amounts indicated in Schedule D in the form of a credit on the utility bill issued under Article III of Chapter 849, Water and Sewage Services and Utility Bill.
- D. The rebate amount in Subsections A, B and C shall be prorated based on the appropriate billing frequency as set out in § 849-30 of Chapter 849, Water and Sewage Services and Utility Bill, to reflect the appropriate portion of a full-year rebate amount.
- E. If the rebate in Subsections A, B and C represents a credit on the utility bill as set out in Article III of Chapter 849, Water and Sewer Services and Utility Bill, the credit shall be applied to any applicable fees related to water and sewage services that appear on the utility bill in accordance with Chapter 849, Water and Sewage Services and Utility Bill.
- C. Append to Chapter 844 as Schedule D the attached schedule to this by-law identified as Schedule 844-1.
