BY-LAW No. 956-2016

To amend By-law No. 212-2016, being a by-law to amend By-law No. 25032 of the former City of Scarborough, to exempt expanded space used for the Eglinton Square Branch Library from taxation for municipal and school purposes.

Whereas at its meeting of February 18, 1997, the Council of the former City of Scarborough adopted By-law No. 25032, being a by-law to exempt certain Premises for municipal and school purposes, namely the Eglinton Square Branch Library; and

Whereas the City of Toronto is the successor at law of the former City of Scarborough, and all by-laws of the former City of Scarborough are deemed by-laws of the City of Toronto; and

Whereas the Board and KS Eglinton Square Inc., the current owner of Eglinton Square Shopping Centre, entered into a Lease Amending Agreement dated October 23, 2015 for the use of expanded premises by the Board; and

Whereas City Council enacted By-law No. 212-2016 to amend By-law No. 25032 to provide a property tax exemption for the expanded premises occupied by the Board, which expanded premises are further described in Schedule 1 to By-law No. 212-2016; and

Whereas By-law No. 212-2016 identified the incorrect Assessment Roll Number for the expanded premises; and

Whereas it is necessary to amend By-law No. 212-2016 to correct the Assessment Roll Number of the expanded premises;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. By-law No. 212-2016 is amended as follows:
 - (1) The Assessment Roll Numbers set out in Schedule A of the By-law are deleted and replaced with "Assessment Roll No. 1901-02-4-280-00400".
