BY-LAW 89-2017

To repeal By-law 966-2014, being a by-law to authorize the entering into of an agreement for the provision of a municipal capital facility at Exhibition Place, 2 Strachan Avenue, for a basketball training facility.

Whereas, at its meeting of August 25, 26, 27 and 28, 2014, City Council authorized the City to enter into a municipal capital facility agreement and provide a property tax exemption for a portion of a proposed basketball practice facility at Exhibition Place, and accordingly enacted By-law 966-2014, being a by-law to authorize the entering into of an agreement for the provision of a municipal capital facility at Exhibition Place, 2 Strachan Avenue, for a basketball training facility; and

Whereas City Council has rescinded its decision to declare a municipal capital facility at Exhibition Place for a basketball training facility conditional upon a commitment by Maple Leaf Sports and Entertainment (MLSE) for the provision of community use for the Youth Centre for Sport Development at 261 Jarvis Street to the satisfaction of the General Manager, Parks, Forestry and Recreation in consultation with the Chief Financial Officer and City Solicitor; and

Whereas the required commitment was made by MLSE pursuant to an Agreement dated October 25, 2016 with the City;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. City of Toronto By-law 966-2014 is repealed.
