BY-LAW 100-2017

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Ossington Avenue and Dewson Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule III (Prohibited Pedestrian Crossings) in § 950-1302, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Location)
Ossington Avenue	Between the south curb line of Dewson Street (east leg) and a point 30.5 metres north of the north curb line of Dewson Street (east leg)

B. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (Prohibited Turns) in § 950-1322, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Intersection or Portion of Highway)	(In Column 2 Direction)	(In Column 3 Turns Prohibited)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)
Ossington Avenue and Dewson Street	Northbound and Southbound	Right	When traffic control signal shows red

C. By deleting from Schedule XXXVIII (Pedestrian Crossovers) in § 950-1337, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Location)
Ossington Avenue	Immediately south of Dewson Street (south intersection)

D. By inserting in Schedule XXXIX (Traffic Control Signals) in § 950-1338, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In
Column 1
Intersection/Location)
