BY-LAW 116-2017

To appoint and delineate certain duties and responsibilities of the City Solicitor for the City of Toronto.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Subject to section 2 of this By-law, Wendy Walberg is appointed City Solicitor for the City of Toronto effective February 15, 2017 and shall have all the powers and duties imposed upon the Solicitor by Article V of Chapter 169, Officials, City, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code.
2. This by-law shall come into force on February 15, 2017 if Wendy Walberg has entered into an employment contract with the City of Toronto on or before February 15, 2017.
