BY-LAW 173-2017

To authorize the alteration of Russett Avenue, between Bloor Street West and Wallace Avenue by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Russett Avenue, between Bloor Street West and Wallace Avenue was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Russett Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Russett Avenue, between Bloor Street West and Wallace Avenue by the installation of six speed humps as shown on Drawing 421G-1586 dated December 2016 attached to this By-law is authorized.
