BY-LAW 212-2017

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 349, Animals, to correct technical errors with respect to changes made by By-law 102-2017.

Whereas at its meetings of December 13, 14 and 15, 2016 and January 31, 2017 City Council adopted By-law 102-2017, which amended Municipal Code Chapter 349, Animals; and

Whereas Chapter 349, Animals, requires minor technical amendments to accurately reflect the amendments adopted by City Council and to align the amendments with the provisions set out in Attachment 1 to the staff report; and

Whereas under § 169-26 of Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 349, Animals, is amended as follows:
 - A. By adding as a new subsection to § 349-8, the following:
 - C. A person who has tethered an animal shall ensure that the animal is tethered in a manner that constrains the animal to the property to which the animal is tethered.
