BY-LAW 231-2017

To permanently close part of the public highway known as Hocken Avenue, at the rear of 81 Ellsworth Avenue.

Whereas a portion of the public highway known as Hocken Avenue, at the rear of 81 Ellsworth Avenue, was inadvertently dedicated as public highway pursuant to By-law 652-2011 immediately prior to the sale of this portion of the highway to the owners of 81 Ellsworth Avenue; and

Whereas it is recommended that part of the public highway known as Hocken Avenue, at the rear of 81 Ellsworth Avenue, be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close part of the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Toronto and East York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on February 22, 2017;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Part of the public highway known as Hocken Avenue, at the rear of 81 Ellsworth Avenue, described as follows, is permanently closed as a public highway:
