BY-LAW 312-2017

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, to remove the fixed fine system for parking tickets.

Whereas City Council, at its meeting of March 28 and 29, 2017, adopted as amended, the recommendations of the Government Management Committee to remove the fixed fine system for all parking ticket offences;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Section 886-18 of Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by deleting Subsections C, D and E and inserting a new Subsection C as follows:
 - C. Every person convicted of an offence under this Chapter is liable to a fine as provided for in the *Provincial Offences Act*.
- 2. This by-law shall come into effect on April 10, 2017.
