BY-LAW 337-2017

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Du Maurier Boulevard.

The North York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Du Maurier Boulevard	South	A point 20 metres east of Yonge Street and the east end of Du Maurier Boulevard	8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., Mon. to Sat.
Du Maurier Boulevard	South	A point 9 metres east of Yonge Street and a point 11 metres further east	Anytime (car-share vehicles excepted)

B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Du Maurier Boulevard	South	Yonge Street and the east end of Du Maurier Boulevard	8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., Mon. to Sat.

C. By inserting in Schedule XV (Parking for Restricted Periods) in § 950-1314, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Maximum Period Permitted)
Du Maurier Boulevard	South	Yonge Street and a point 20 metres east	10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Mon. to Sat.	1 hour

D. By deleting from Schedule XLIII (Car-Share Vehicle Parking Areas) in § 950-1342, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Number of Spaces)	(From Column 5 Car-Share Organization/Company)
Du Maurier Boulevard	South	A point 9 metres east of Yonge Street and a point 11 metres further east	2	Zipcar
