## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 371-2017

#### **To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting Adelaide Street West, Byron Avenue, Highcroft Road, Queensdale Avenue, Roxton Road and Westlake Avenue.**

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
  - A. By deleting from Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Time or Days)
Adelaide Street West	North	A point 87 metres west of Tecumseth Street and a point 5.5 metres further west	Anytime
Queensdale Avenue	North	A point 54 metres east of Glebemount Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime during the months of May, July, Sept. and Nov.
Queensdale Avenue	South	A point 52 metres east of Glebemount Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further east	Anytime during the months of Jan., Feb., Mar., Apr., June, Aug., Oct. and Dec.

- B. By inserting in Schedule II (Designated On-Street Parking for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Byron Avenue	East	A point 39.5 metres north of Chatham Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
Highcroft Road	East	A point 52 metres north of Cairns Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
Roxton Road	West	A point 9.1 metres south of Dewson Street (east leg) and a point 5 metres further south	Anytime
Westlake Avenue	East	A point 13.5 metres south of Harris Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further south	Anytime
Westlake Avenue	West	A point 23 metres north of Stephenson Avenue and a point 5.5 metres further north	Anytime
