## BY-LAW 478-2017

## To appoint a Fire Chief and General Manager, Toronto Fire Services.

Whereas under subsection 6(1) of the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997*, S.O. 1997, c. 4, as amended, the Council of a municipality in which a fire department is established shall appoint a fire chief for the fire department; and

Whereas under § 79-2 and § 79-3 of The City of Toronto Municipal Code, Council has established the Fire Services Division to serve as the fire department under the direction of the Fire Chief to provide fire protection services for the City; and

Whereas under § 79-1 of the Municipal Code, the Fire Chief shall be appointed by Council on the recommendation of the City Manager;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Subject to Section 2, Matthew Pegg is appointed Fire Chief and General Manager of Toronto Fire Services, effective April 27, 2017.
- 2. This by-law comes into force on April 27, 2017 if Matthew Pegg has entered into an employment contract with the City on or before May 3, 2017.
- 3. Upon his appointment as Fire Chief and General Manager of Toronto Fire Services pursuant to section 1, Matthew Pegg shall have, in addition to any powers, rights and duties assigned to a fire chief under *Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997*, S.O. 1997, c. 4, as amended, or by any other statute or by-law of the City, all the responsibilities and authority of the Fire Chief under Chapter 79, Fire Services, of The City of Toronto Municipal Code.
- 4. On the date this by-law comes into force, By-law 938-2012 is repealed.
