BY-LAW 492-2017

To authorize the alteration of Kennedy Avenue by the installation of traffic calming islands.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Kennedy Avenue was conducted, and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of traffic calming pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Etobicoke York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Kennedy Avenue;

The Etobicoke York Community Council enacts:

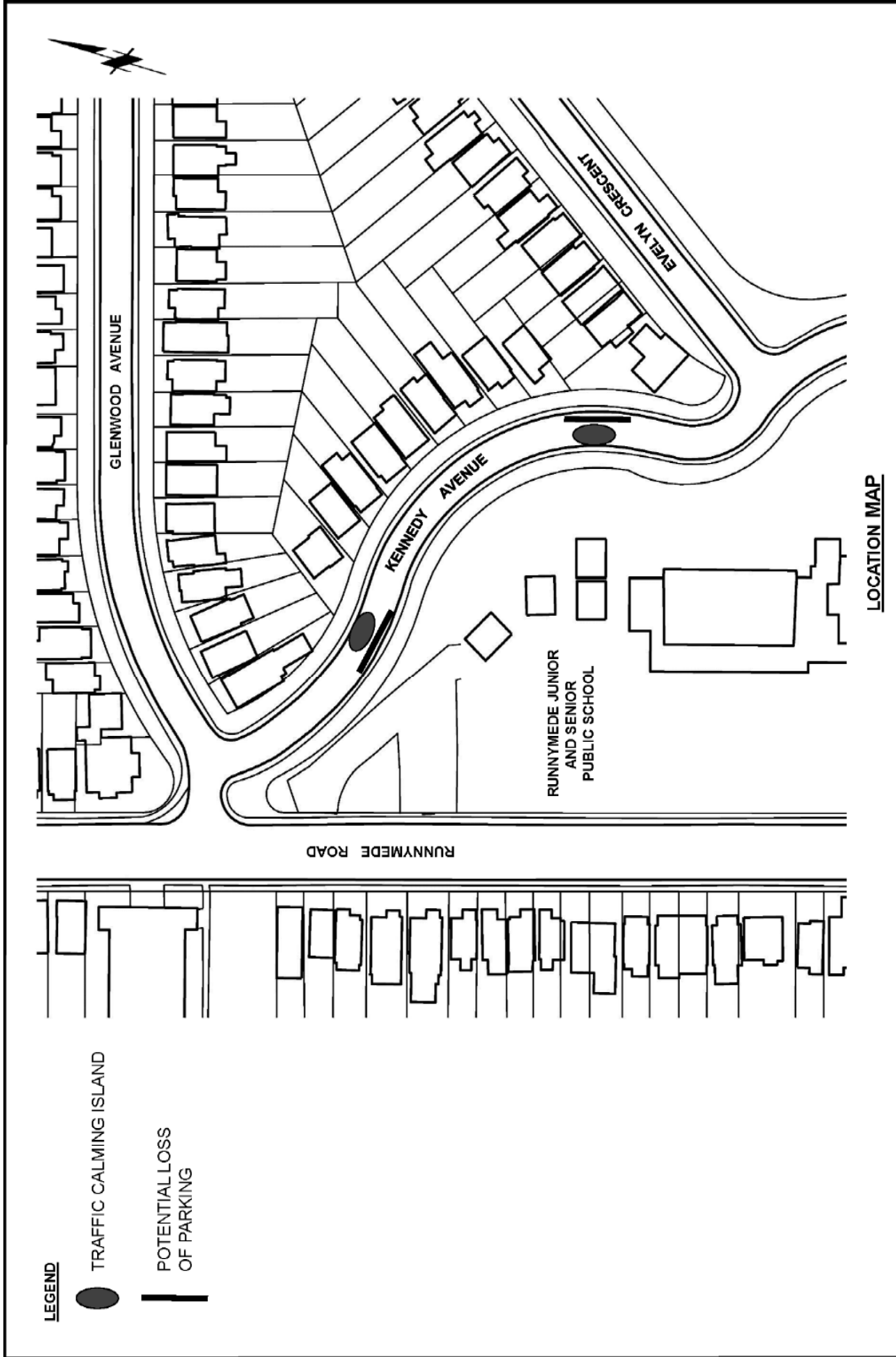
