BY-LAW 528-2017

To authorize the alteration of Braemar Avenue, between Chaplin Crescent and Eglinton Avenue West by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Braemar Avenue, between Chaplin Crescent and Eglinton Avenue West was conducted, and although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Braemar Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Braemar Avenue, between Chaplin Crescent and Eglinton Avenue West, by the installation of seven speed humps, generally as shown on Drawing 421G-2150 dated May 2016 attached to this By-law is authorized.
