BY-LAW 842-2017

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 918, Parking on Residential Front Yards and Boulevards, to restrict the grounds for front yard parking and boulevard parking appeals.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 918, Parking on Residential Front Yards and Boulevards, is amended by inserting a new subsection 918-21C as follows:
 - C. Despite Subsection A, in addition to any other appeal requirement and/or right under this chapter, no appeal shall be accepted for a front yard parking application and/or boulevard parking application unless the grounds for that appeal is:
 - (1) a refusal of the application on the basis of a negative poll result; and/or
 - (2) a refusal of the application on the basis of § 918-8C(3).
2. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.

Enacted and passed on July 7, 2017.
