BY-LAW 933-2017

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Ontario Street.

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:

A. By deleting from Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Side)	(From Column 3 Between)	(From Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Ontario Street	East	Queen Street East and a point 9 metres south of Adelaide Street East	Anytime
Ontario Street	East	Richmond Street East and Queen Street East	Anytime
Ontario Street	West	Richmond Street East and Adelaide Street East	Anytime

B. By inserting in Schedule XIII (No Parking) in § 950-1312, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Ontario Street	East	A point 9 metres south of Richmond Street East and Queen Street East	Anytime
Ontario Street	East	Adelaide Street East and a point 89 metres south of Richmond Street East	Anytime

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Ontario Street	West	Adelaide Street East and a point 89 metres south of Richmond Street East	Anytime

- C. By inserting in Schedule XIV (No Stopping) in § 950-1313, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Prohibited Times and/or Days)
Ontario Street	Both	A point 9 metres south of Richmond Street East and a point 80 metres further south	Anytime

2. This By-law shall be effective commencing September 13, 2017.
