BY-LAW 1052-2017

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds, to establish a reserve account named the Police Modernization Reserve Account.

- 2. Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds, be amended by adding the following to Schedule No. 1 Corporate Reserves:
