BY-LAW 1053-2017

To further amend By-law 15-92 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto respecting pensions and other benefits.

Whereas By-law 15-92 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, a by-law "To provide pensions for employees, their spouses and children of the Metropolitan Corporation and other participating employers", as amended, governs the Metropolitan Toronto Pension Plan; and

Whereas it is desired to amend the definition of "spouse" in the said by-law to accord with a recent amendment to the *Pension Benefits Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. By-law 15-92 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, as amended, is further amended by striking out the text of item 1(1)(ee)(ii)(B) and substituting the following:

"of some permanence, if they are the parents of a child, as set out in the *Children's Law Reform Act*".

2. This by-law shall be deemed to have come into force on January 1, 2017.

Enacted and passed by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the Members of Council present and voting on October 4, 2017.
