BY-LAW 1054-2017

To amend further By-law 181-81 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto respecting pensions and other benefits.

Whereas By-law 181-81 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, a by-law "To provide pensions and death benefits to members of the Metropolitan Police Force", as amended, governs both the fund known as the "Metropolitan Toronto Police Benefit Fund" and the pension plan which it underwrites; and

Whereas it is desired to amend the definition of "widow" in the said by-law to accord with a recent amendment to the *Pension Benefits Act*;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. By-law 181-81 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, as amended, to date is further amended by striking out the text of subclause 1(1)(z)(ii) and substituting the following:

"of some permanence, if they are the parents of a child, as set out in the *Children's Law Reform Act*".

2. This by-law shall be deemed to have come into force on January 1, 2017.

Enacted and passed by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the Members of Council present and voting on October 4, 2017.
