BY-LAW 1055-2017

To amend further By-law 380-74 of the former City of Toronto with respect to pensions and other benefits.

Whereas By-law 380-74 of the former Corporation of the City of Toronto, a by-law "To establish a pension plan to be known as the '1974 IMPROVED PLAN'", as amended, governs the Toronto Civic Employees' Pension and Benefit Fund; and

Whereas it is desired to amend certain definitions in the said by-law to accord with a recent amendment to the *Pension Benefits Act* regarding spousal status;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Subsection 1 of By-law 380-74 of the former Corporation of the City of Toronto, as amended to date is further amended by striking out that part of clause (d) of each of the definitions of "Post Retirement Spouse" and "Spouse", after December 31, 1987" immediately following the words "conjugal relationship" where they appear and substituting the following:

"if they are the parents of a child as set out in the *Children's Law Reform Act*".

2. This by-law shall be deemed to have come into force on January 1, 2017.
