**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW 1066-2017**

**To permanently close part of the public highway located at the rear of 23 Morton Road.**

Whereas it is recommended that part of the public highway located at the rear of 23 Morton Road be permanently closed as a public highway; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close part of the said highway was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 162 and the Toronto and East York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on September 6, 2017;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Part of the public highway located at the rear of 23 Morton Road, described as follows, is permanently closed as a public highway:

Part of Lane, Plan 1184, East Toronto, Lying East of Morton Road, City of Toronto, being Part of PIN 21014-1125 (LT) and designated as Part 3 on Plan 66R-29437.
