BY-LAW 1169-2017

To authorize the alteration of Grant Street, between Queen Street East and Kintyre Avenue, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Grant Street, between Queen Street East and Kintyre Avenue was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Grant Street;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

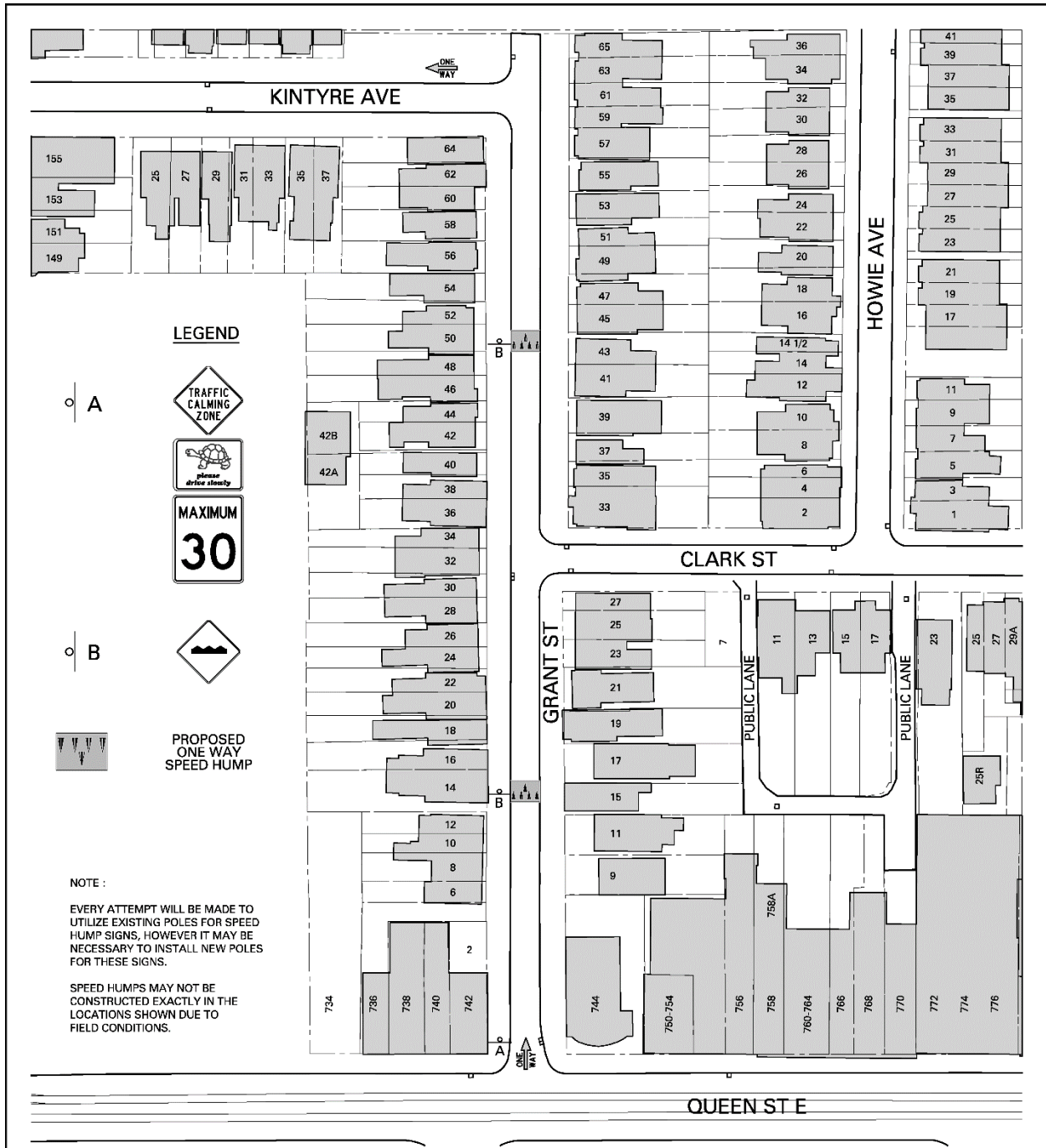
