## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 1247-2017

#### To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting King Street East and King Street West.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
  - A. By inserting in Schedule III (Designated On-Street Loading Zones for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
King Street East	North	A point 37 metres west of Victoria Street and a point 18 metres further west	Anytime
King Street East	South	A point 38 metres east of Leader Lane and a point 18 metres further east	Anytime
King Street West	North	A point 39 metres west of Widmer Street and a point 18 metres further west	Anytime
King Street West	North	A point 50.1 metres west of Yonge Street and a point 30 metres further west	Anytime
King Street West	North	A point 67.5 metres east of Bathurst Street and a point 18 metres further east	Anytime
King Street West	South	A point 15.2 metres east of Jordan Street and a point 18 metres further east	Anytime
King Street West	South	A point 33.9 metres west of Bay Street and a point 21.5 metres further west	Anytime
King Street West	South	A point 37.7 metres west of Spadina Avenue and a point 18 metres further west	Anytime

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Side)	(In Column 3 Between)	(In Column 4 Time or Days)
King Street West	South	A point 71 metres east of John Street and a point 18 metres further east	Anytime
King Street West	South	A point 147.4 metres east of Blue Jays Way and a point 18 metres further east	Anytime
King Street West	South	A point 151.1 metres east of Spadina Avenue and a point 18 metres further east	Anytime

2. This By-law shall be effective commencing November 12, 2017.
