BY-LAW 1247-2017

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, respecting King Street East and King Street West.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- **1.** Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:
- A. By inserting in Schedule III (Designated On-Street Loading Zones for Permit Holders), the following in alphabetical order by street name:
