BY-LAW 1265-2017

To repeal the appointment of Ann Borooah as Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto and to amend By-law 226-1998 to appoint Diane Elizabeth Damiano as Chief Building Official on an interim basis.

Whereas subsection 3(2) of the *Building Code Act, 1992* required the council of each municipality to appoint a Chief Building Official; and

Whereas City Council appointed Ann Borooah Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto pursuant to By-law 863-2001; and

Whereas Ann Borooah has recently passed away and Council has determined that Diane Elizabeth Damiano, a Deputy Chief Building Official, be appointed Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto on an interim basis; and

Whereas By-law 226-1998 appointed a Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto and, certain Deputy Chief Building Officials;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. By-law 863-2001 is repealed;
2. By-law 226-1998, as amended is further amended:
 - A. By deleting subsection 1(1) and replacing it with the following:

Diane Elizabeth Damiano is appointed Interim Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto.
 - B. By deleting subsection (2) and replacing it with the following:

Subsection (1) remains in full force and effect until a by-law appointing a new Chief Building Official comes into effect.
3. This by-law comes into effect on the day it is passed by Council.
