BY-LAW 1317-2017

To authorize the alteration of Belsize Drive, between Harwood Road and Hadley Road, by the installation of speed humps.

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Belsize Drive, between Harwood Road and Hadley Road, was conducted, and as the results were favourable pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Belsize Drive;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

1. The alteration of Belsize Drive, between Harwood Road and Hadley Road, by the installation of two speed humps generally as shown on Drawing No. 421G-2558 dated July 2017 attached to this By-law is authorized.
