**BY-LAW 1318-2017**

**To authorize the alteration of Empire Avenue, between Eastern Avenue and Queen Street East, by the installation of speed humps.**

Whereas a traffic calming poll of households on Empire Avenue, between Eastern Avenue and Queen Street East, was conducted and, although the poll did not satisfy the polling criteria for the installation of speed humps pursuant to the City's Traffic Calming Policy, Toronto and East York Community Council deems it appropriate to undertake the installation of speed humps on Empire Avenue;

The Toronto and East York Community Council enacts:

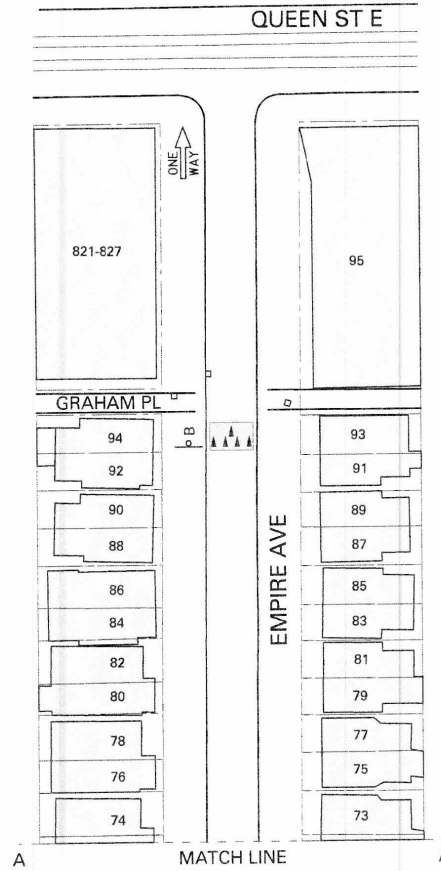
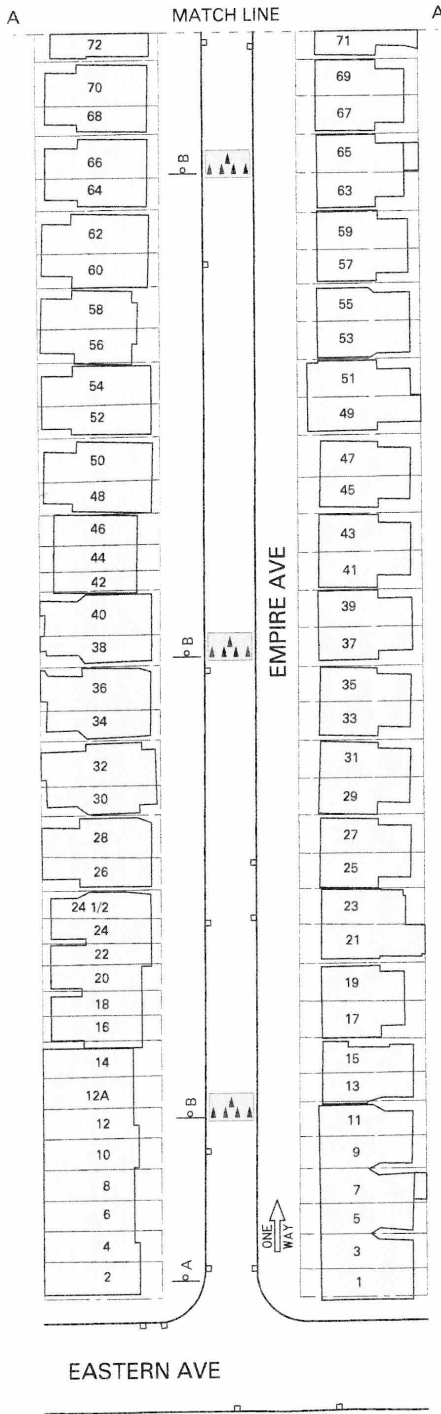
