BY-LAW 1377-2017

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 918, Parking on Residential Front Yards and Boulevards, with respect to front yard parking and boulevard parking appeals.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Municipal Code Chapter 918, Parking on Residential Front Yards and Boulevards, is amended by:
 - A. adding a new subsection 918-21D which reads as follows:
 - D. Subsection C shall not apply to a front yard parking application and/or boulevard parking application where all relevant fees had been paid and the elements for that application required by § 918-8 had been received to the satisfaction of the General Manager, Transportation Services, on or before July 31, 2017.
