BY-LAW 339-2018

To appoint William Johnston as Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto and to repeal By-law 1265-2017.

Whereas subsection 3(2) of the Building Code Act, 1992 required the council of each municipality to appoint a Chief Building Official; and

Whereas City Council appointed Diane Elizabeth Damiano as Interim Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto pursuant to By-law 1265-2017; and

Whereas Council has determined that William Johnston be appointed Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto; and

Whereas By-law 226-1998 appointed a Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto and certain Deputy Chief Building Officials;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- **1.** By-law 1265-2017 is repealed;
- 2. By-law 226-1998, as amended, is further amended by deleting subsection 1(1) and replacing it with the following:
 - William Johnston is appointed Chief Building Official for the City of Toronto effective April 9, 2018.
- 3. This by-law comes into force on April 9, 2018, if William Johnston has entered into an employment contract with the City of Toronto on or before April 8, 2018.
