BY-LAW 619-2018

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, respecting Lake Shore Boulevard West at Windermere Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
- A. By deleting from Schedule XIX (One-Way Traffic Lanes) in § 950-1318, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Lanes)	(From Column 4 Times and/or Days)	(From Column 5 Direction)
Lake Shore Boulevard West and Windermere Avenue	Windermere Avenue and a point 106 metres east	Northerly Westbound	Anytime	Westbound right-turning

- B. By inserting in Schedule XIX (One-Way Traffic Lanes) in § 950-1318, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1 Highway)	(In Column 2 Between)	(In Column 3 Lanes)	(In Column 4 Times and/or Days)	(In Column 5 Direction)
Lake Shore Boulevard West and Windermere Avenue	Windermere Avenue and a point 106 metres east	Northerly Westbound	Anytime	Westbound right-turning (buses excepted)
