BY-LAW 653-2018

To amend By-law 1264-2016, being an amendment to former City of Toronto By-law 438-86, as amended, with respect to the lands municipally known in the year 2016 as 126 and 128 Hazelton Avenue.

Whereas authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and

Whereas adequate information was provided to the public and at least one public meeting was held in accordance with the Planning Act prior to Council enacting By-law 1264-2016; and

Whereas Council has determined that a technical amendment to By-law 1264-2016 is appropriate to address an inadvertent omission and that pursuant to Section 34(17) of the Planning Act, no further notice is required;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. City of Toronto By-law 1264-2016, is amended by modifying the list of provisions set out in the first paragraph of Section 3 as follows:
 - Adding reference to Section 12(2)380 by adding a comma and the words "12(2)380" after "12(2)322".
- 2. The provisions of By-law 1264-2016, shall continue to apply except as otherwise provided in this By-law.
