BY-LAW 769-2018

To permanently close the public highways Bredonhill Court and Bagot Court.

Whereas it is recommended that the public highways known as Bredonhill Court and Bagot Court be permanently closed as public highways; and

Whereas notice of the proposed by-law to permanently close the said highways was posted on the notices page of the City's web site in accordance with the requirements of City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 162 and the North York Community Council heard any person who wished to speak to the matter at its meeting held on June 6, 2018;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:
