## **CITY OF TORONTO**

## **BY-LAW 826-2018**

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds, to establish the Investment Stabilization Reserve.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. The Investment Stabilization Reserve is established for the purpose of stabilizing investment income contributions to the operating budget by minimizing in-year variances through receiving funds in years when investment income is in excess of the amount expected in the operating budget and withdrawing funds in years when investment income is below budget.
- 2. Municipal Code Chapter 227, Reserves and Reserve Funds, be amended by adding the following to Appendix B, Schedule No. 3 Stabilization Reserves:
