CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 1318-2018

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking, Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking and By-law 635-2018, respecting free-floating car-share parking permits.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Municipal Code Chapter 925, Permit Parking, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting the phrase "at or above 95 percent capacity" from the definition for FREE-FLOATING CAR-SHARE PARKING PERMIT under § 925-1B and replacing it with the phrase "at or above 100 percent capacity".
 - B. By deleting the phrase "at least 5 percent of permits remain available" from § 925-5M(1) and replacing it with the phrase " the road or permit parking area is not at or above 100 percent capacity" such that § 925-5M(1) now read as follows:
 - (1) Residents, visitors and tradespersons may apply for a temporary permit and this permit shall be issued by the General Manager only for those highways or areas licensed for permit parking under this chapter where on-street permit parking spaces are available after all residents eligible to receive a permit under the priority system established under § 925-5E have had an opportunity to obtain a permit and the road or permit parking area is not at or above 100 percent capacity.
 - C. By deleting the phrase "at least 5 percent of permits remain available" from § 925-5M.1(1) and replacing it with the phrase "the road or permit parking area is not at or above 100 percent capacity" such that § 925-5M.1(1) now read as follows:
 - (1) Residents, visitors and tradespersons may apply for a temporary 24 hour on-street parking permit or a temporary 48 hour on-street parking permit and the permit shall be issued by the General Manager only for those highways or areas licensed for permit parking under this chapter where on-street permit parking spaces are available after all residents eligible to receive a permit under the priority system established under § 925-5E have had an opportunity to obtain a permit and the road or permit parking area is not at or above 100 percent capacity.
 - D. By deleting the phrase "at or above 95 percent capacity (where less than 5 percent of permits remain available)" from § 925-5N(1.1) and replacing it with "at or above 100 percent capacity".

- 2. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting the phrase "at or above 95 percent capacity" from the definition for FREE-FLOATING CAR-SHARE PARKING PERMIT under § 950-101B and replacing it with the phrase "at or above 100 percent capacity".
 - B. By deleting the phrase "at or above 95 percent capacity (where less than 5 percent of permits remain available)" from § 950-400D(5)(b) and replacing it with "at or above 100 percent capacity".
 - C. By deleting \S 950-510C(1)(e) and replacing it as follows:
 - "(e) A complete application for a free-floating car-share parking permit must be received by the General Manager no later than on or before a date 18 months following the date of the issuance of the first free-floating car-share parking permit issued by the General Manager to any car-share organization/company, and the General Manager shall not accept any application or part of an application after that date."
 - D. By deleting § 950-510C(2)(a) and replacing it as follows:
 - "(a) Term of free-floating car-share parking permits
 - (i) Subject to subsection (iii), all free-floating car-share parking permits issued in accordance with this section shall be valid for a term of no more than 12 months.
 - (ii) Subject to subsection (iii), upon the expiry of a freefloating car-share parking permit issued in accordance with subsection (i), free-floating car-share parking permits may be renewed for an additional term of up to 6 months provided the fees are paid, and the car-share organization/company complies with the terms of the permit, and this chapter.
 - (iii) Despite subsections (i) and (ii) above, no free-floating carshare parking permit or renewal permit shall be valid for a term extending later than a date 18 months following the date of the issuance of the first free-floating car-share parking permit issued by the General Manager to any carshare organization/company."
 - E. By deleting the phrase "November 30, 2019." from § 950-510C(5)(a) and replacing it with the phrase "the end of the permit term."
 - F. By deleting the phrase "at or above 95 percent capacity (where less than 5 percent of permits remain available)" from § 950-510C(6)(a) and replacing it with "at or above 100 percent capacity".

- G. By deleting the phrase "November 30, 2019." from § 950-510C(6)(f)[2] and replacing it with the phrase "the end of the permit term."
- **3.** Section 1E of City of Toronto By-law 635-2018 is deleted and replaced as follows:
 - "E. By adding a new section (1.2) to § 925-5N as follows:
 - (1.2) Despite any other by-law to the contrary, including Chapter 27, Council Procedures, Community Councils have the delegated authority to add, remove and/or exclude any permit parking area or road on which permit parking applies to or from Schedule C to this chapter provided that:
 - (a) the General Manager has brought forward to Community Council any recommended changes to permit parking streets and/or areas deemed necessary;
 - (b) three months' notice was provided in accordance with Chapter 162, Notice, Public, before the potential addition, removal and/or exclusion of the road or permit parking area to or from Schedule C is considered by Community Council; and
 - (c) The addition, removal or exclusion of any permit parking area or road on which permit parking applies to or from Schedule C to this chapter by Community Council shall take effect on a date three months following the decision of Community Council to add, remove and/or exclude the permit parking area or road to or from Schedule C to this chapter."
- 4. Section 3 of City of Toronto By-law 635-2018 is amended by deleting the phrase "December 1, 2018." and replacing it with the phrase "six months after the issuance of the first free-floating car-share parking permit by the General Manager, Transportation Services, pursuant to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking."
