CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 901-2019

To amend former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 285, Rooming Houses.

Whereas it is necessary to make technical amendments to former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 285, Rooming Houses;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 285, Rooming Houses By-law is amended by:
 - (a) deleting the word "Hospital" in § 285-4.F.(7)(d) and replacing it with "Health";
 - (b) deleting "Fire Marshals Act" in the definition of "applicable law" in § 285-7 and in § 285-14.A.(3)(a) and replacing it with "Fire Protection and Promotion Act, 1997";
 - (c) deleting the definition of "City Commissioner" in § 285-7;
 - (d) adding "of" after "Living accommodation comprising" in the definition of "dwelling unit" in § 285-7;
 - (e) adding the following definition of "Executive Director" after the definition of "Dwelling Unit" in § 285-7:

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR – The Executive Director of Municipal Licensing and Standards or their designate or successor.

- (f) deleting "City Commissioner" wherever it occurs and replacing it with "Executive Director"; and
- (g) deleting "210, Housing Standards" in § 285-14.A.(3)(b) and replacing it with "629, Property Standards".
