

## CITY OF TORONTO

### BY-LAW 953-2019

**To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 610, Penalties, Administration of, City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, and City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, to convert existing parking prohibitions in the vicinity of fire halls to stopping prohibitions.**

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, is amended as follows:
  - A. By deleting Subsection (6) from § 950-400E.
  - B. By inserting a new section B.2 in § 950-400 as follows:
    - B.2 Where authorized signs to that effect are displayed, no person shall stop any vehicle on any highway within a distance of up to 7.5 metres of any fire hall on the side of the highway on which the fire hall is located or within a distance of up to 30.5 metres of such fire hall on the opposite side of the highway.
2. Municipal Code Chapter 610, Penalties, Administration of, is amended as follows:
  - A. By deleting from Schedule A, Table 10: Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, the following in numeric order by Designated Part of Chapter:

§ 950-400E(6)	Park – Signed Highway – Within 7.5 metres of Fire Hall – Same Side	\$40.00
§ 950-400E(6)	Park – Signed Highway – Within 30.5 metres of Fire Hall – Opposite Side	\$40.00

- B. By inserting into Schedule A, Table 10: Chapter 950, Traffic and Parking, the following in numeric order by Designated Part of Chapter:

<b>(In Column 1 Designated Part of Chapter)</b>	<b>(In Column 2 Short Form Wording)</b>	<b>(In Column 3 Penalty Amount)</b>
§ 950-400B.2	Stop – Signed Highway – Within 7.5 Metres of Fire Hall – Same Side	\$60.00
§ 950-400B.2	Stop – Signed Highway – Within 30.5 Metres of Fire Hall – Opposite Side	\$60.00

3. Municipal Code Chapter 903, Parking for Persons with Disabilities, is amended as follows:

- A. By deleting Subsection (5) from § 903-6C.
