## BY-LAW 512-2020

To repeal former City of Scarborough By-law 24145, being a By-law authorizing the demolition and clearing of the lands and premises known municipally as 199 Galloway Road, in the City of Scarborough.

Whereas on April 27, 1994 the former City of Scarborough registered Scarborough By-law 24145 on title to 199 Galloway Road authorizing the Commissioner of Planning and Buildings to clear the property of a dilapidated building and to clean and grade the lot, as Instrument Number C892202; and

Whereas the building was subsequently brought into compliance with By-law 24145;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- **1.** Former City of Scarborough By-law 24145 is repealed.
- 2. The City Solicitor is authorized to register this repealing by-law on title to 199 Galloway Road, in the former City of Scarborough.
