BY-LAW 803-2020

To technically amend Zoning By-law 569-2013, as amended, with respect to the condition for retail store uses in combination with manufacturing uses in the Employment Industrial Office zone.

Whereas City Council has delegated to the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, by Section 169-5.2B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the authority to submit bills directly to Council to correct technical errors; and

 - (A) Amend Regulation 60.40.20.100(23) by replacing "In the EO zone, a **retail** store:" with "In the EO zone, a **retail store** on a **lot** with a **manufacturing use**:"
