BY-LAW 846-2020

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing with respect to reducing the risk from COVID-19 at establishments serving food and drink.

Whereas City Council wishes to extend the amendments made by By-law 665-2020 to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing until 11:59:59 p.m. on October 7, 2020 until further amendments take effect;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. Section 545-8.4.1.C of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 545, Licensing, is replaced by the following new provision:
 - C. Each provision of § 545-8.4.1 comes into force seven days after the date of its enactment and is deemed to be no longer in effect and revoked at 11:59:59 p.m. on October 7, 2020.
- 2. Section 2 of By-law 665-2020 is amended by deleting the phrase "and is deemed to be no longer in effect and revoked at 12:01 a.m. on the first day after the first Council meeting after the summer recess (currently scheduled for September 30 and October 1, 2020), unless extended by City Council".
