

CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 1053-2020

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Strachan Avenue.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:

- A. By deleting from Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (From Column 1 Highway) | (From Column 2 Between) | (From Column 3 Lanes) | (From Column 4 Times or Days) |
|-------------------------|--|---|-------------------------------|
| Strachan Avenue | Fleet Street and a point approximately 30 metres north of King Street West | Easterly Northbound and Westerly Southbound | Anytime |
| Strachan Avenue | Lake Shore Boulevard West and Fleet Street | Easterly Northbound | Anytime |
| Strachan Avenue | Lake Shore Boulevard West and Fleet Street | Westerly Southbound | Anytime |

- B. By inserting in Schedule D (Designated Lanes for Bicycles) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Between) | (In Column 3 Lanes) | (In Column 4 Times or Days) |
|-----------------------|--|---|-----------------------------|
| Strachan Avenue | Wellington Street West and a point approximately 30 metres north of King Street West | Easterly Northbound and Westerly Southbound | Anytime |

C. By inserting in Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

| (In Column 1 Highway) | (In Column 2 Between) | (In Column 3 Lanes) | (In Column 4 Times or Days) |
|-----------------------------|---|--|-----------------------------------|
| Strachan Avenue | Lake Shore Boulevard West and Wellington Street West | Easterly Northbound and Westerly Southbound | Anytime |
