CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW 1162-2020

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 719, Snow and Ice Removal, to update the reference to "the Commissioner of Works and Emergency Services" and to update the reference to "section 326 of the Municipal Act".

Whereas the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, may submit bills directly to Council to make technical amendments to the Municipal Code and other by-laws to correct technical errors, to update the by-laws to refer to the current statute, City official title, administrative unit and Municipal Code provision and to repeal by-laws of the former municipalities that have been superseded by provisions in the Municipal Code or as a result of an administrative reorganization; and

Whereas the official title of what previously was the Commissioner of Works and Emergency Services is now the General Manager of Transportation Services for the City of Toronto; and

Whereas the City of Toronto is now governed by the City of Toronto Act, 2006 and section 326 of the Municipal Act is found in section 386 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 719, Snow and Ice Removal, is amended by:
 - A. deleting the phrase "the Commissioner of Works and Emergency Services or a person appointed by the Commissioner" where it appears in § 719-3A and replacing it with the phrase "the General Manager of Transportation Services for the City of Toronto or designate or successor".
 - B. deleting the phrase "Commissioner of Works and Emergency Services" where it appears in § 719-3B and replacing it with the phrase "General Manager of Transportation Services for the City of Toronto or designate or successor".
 - C. deleting the phrase "by section 326 of the Municipal Act" where it appears in § 719-3C and replacing it with the phrase "by section 386 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006".
