BY-LAW 1176-2020

To make a technical amendment to By-law 1268-2018, being a by-law to amend Chapters 320 and 324 of the former Etobicoke Zoning Code as amended by By-law 1088-2002 and By-law 735-2014(OMB), with respect to the lands municipally known in the year 2020 as 5365 Dundas Street West.

Whereas City Council has delegated to the City Solicitor, in consultation with the City Clerk, by Section 169-5.2B of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 169, Officials, City, the authority to submit bills directly to Council to correct technical errors; and

Whereas there was an error in By-law 1268-2018, as the specific reference to sections 9 and 10 of By-law 1268-2018 found in sections 15(a) and 15(b) of By-law 1268-2018 were incorrectly referenced in error by the By-law enacted by Council, as sections 9 and 10 of By-law 1268-2018 do not address parking calculations;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. The specific reference to sections 9 and 10 of By-law 1268-2018 found in sections 15(a) and 15(b) of By-law 1268-2018 are deleted.
