BY-LAW 522-2021

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 466, Fireworks, and Chapter 608, Parks, to ban the possession of fireworks in City parks.

Whereas under section 8 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, the City may pass by-laws in respect of the economic, social and environmental well-being of the City, the health, safety and well-being of persons and protection of persons and property; and

Whereas Council has authorized amendments to ban the possession of fireworks in City parks;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 466, Fireworks, is amended by:
 - A. adding a new subsection § 466-4F as follows:
 - F. No person shall possess any fireworks in a public park.
 - B. amending \S 466-5C(2) so that it reads as follows:
 - On or into any highway, street, lane, square, public park or other public place;
- 2. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 608, Parks, is amended so that § 608-5 reads as follows:

§ 608-5. Fireworks.

While in a park, no person shall possess, ignite, discharge or set off firecrackers, rockets or other fireworks.
