AMENDMENT 549 TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN

LANDS MUNICIPALLY KNOWN IN THE YEAR 2020 AS 145-155 BALMORAL AVENUE

The Official Plan of the City of Toronto is amended as follows:

- 1. Chapter 6, Section 6, Yonge-St. Clair Secondary Plan is amended as follows:
- 2. Section 8, Site and Area Specific Policies, is amended by adding the following Site and Area Specific Policy 15, together with the key map as shown on the attached Schedule 2, as follows:
 - 15. 145-155 Balmoral Avenue

For the lands shown as Area 15 on Map 6-2, a maximum building height of 46.0 metres, excluding mechanical penthouse, is permitted provided the building is used as a retirement home and/or nursing home and transitions downward towards a 1-storey building element in the eastern portion of the site.
