The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

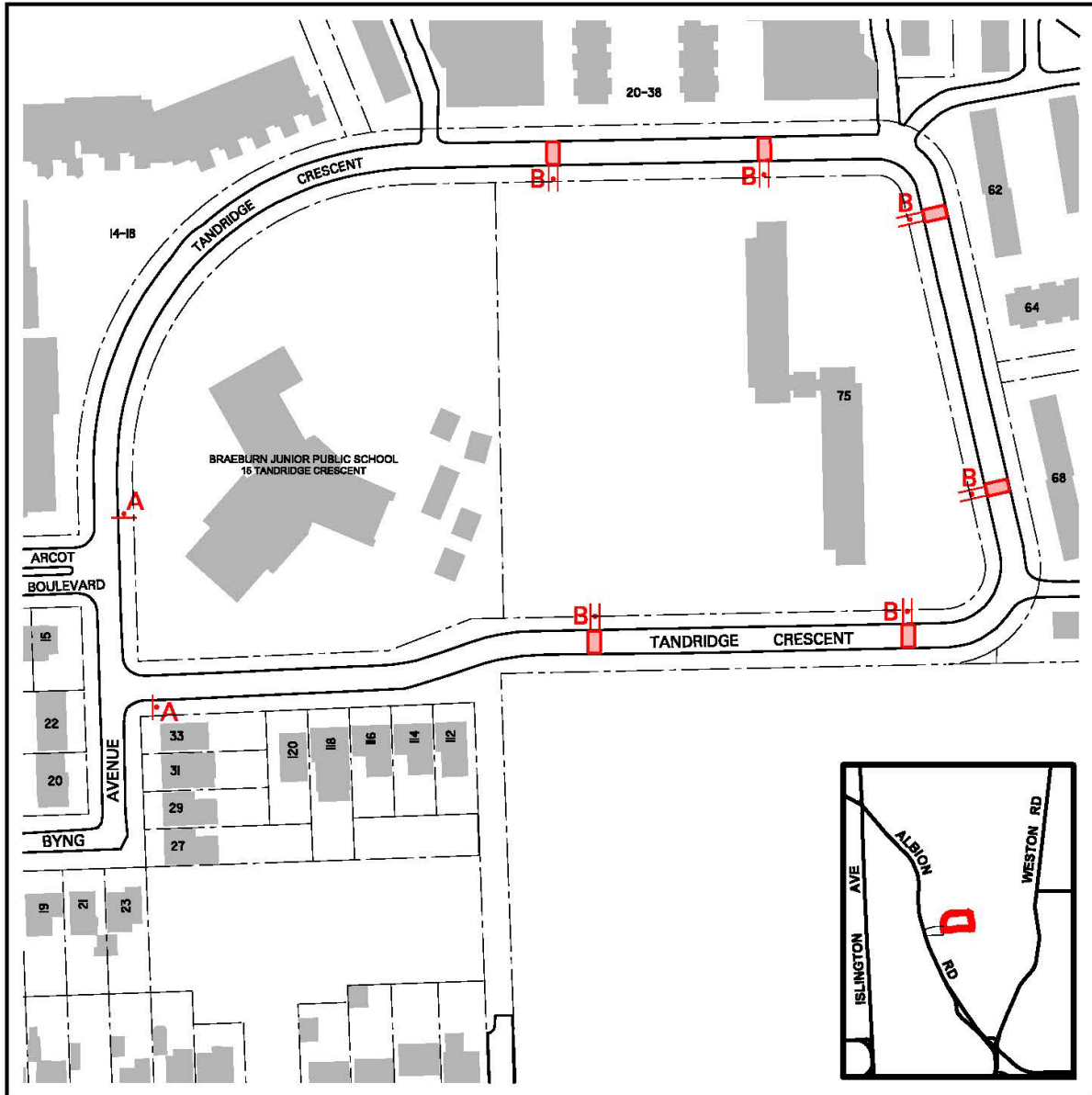
