BY-LAW 921-2021

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes and Cycle Tracks, respecting Saulter Street South.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 886, Footpaths, Pedestrian Ways, Bicycle Paths, Bicycle Lanes, and Cycle Tracks, is amended as follows:
 - A. By deleting from Schedule E (Cycle Tracks) the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(From Column 1 Highway)	(From Column 2 Between)	(From Column 3 Lanes)	(From Column 4 Times or Days)
Saulter Street South	Villiers Street and Commissioners Street	Westerly northbound lane adjacent to the westerly southbound cycle track	Anytime
