BY-LAW 208-2022

To amend By-law 541-2020, as amended by By-law 664-2020, By-law 845-2020, By-law 58-2021, By-law 263-2021, By-law 368-2021, By-law 483-2021, By-law 830-2021 and By-law 1106-2021; and By-law 664-2020, as amended by By-law 845-2020, By-law 58-2021, By-law 483-2021, By-law 830-2021 and By-law 1106-2021, with respect to the wearing of masks or other face coverings.

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. City of Toronto By-law 541-2020, as amended by City of Toronto By-law 664-2020, City of Toronto By-law 845-2020, City of Toronto By-law 58-2021, City of Toronto By-law 263-2021, City of Toronto By-law 368-2021, City of Toronto By-law 483-2021, City of Toronto By-law 830-2021 and City of Toronto By-law 1106-2021, is further amended by deleting section 9 and replacing it with the following:
 - 9. Each provision of this By-law, except section 7.1 which came into force on June 7, 2020, shall come into force 7 days after the date of enactment and this By-law in its entirety is deemed to be no longer in effect and revoked upon any one or more of the requirements related to the wearing of masks in the Roadmap Exit Step of O. Reg. 364/20: Rules for Areas at Step 3 and at the Roadmap Exit Step under the Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020 being amended, revoked, or ceasing to apply to the City of Toronto.
- 2. City of Toronto By-law 664-2020, as amended by City of Toronto By-law 845-2020, City of Toronto By-law 58-2021, City of Toronto By-law 483-2021, By-law 830-2021 and By-law 1106-2021, is amended by deleting section 8 and replacing it with the following:
 - 8. This By-law shall come into force 7 days after the date of enactment and is deemed to be no longer in effect and revoked upon any one or more of the requirements related to the wearing of masks in the Roadmap Exit Step of O. Reg. 364/20: Rules for Areas at Step 3 and at the Roadmap Exit Step under the Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020 being amended, revoked, or ceasing to apply to the City of Toronto.
