BY-LAW 255-2022

To amend City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 349, Animals, to extend the backyard hen-keeping pilot project.

Whereas under section 8 of the City of Toronto Act, 2006, the City may pass by-laws respecting animals;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

- 1. City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 349, Animals, is amended so § 349-4.1A reads as follows:
 - A. The Executive Director is authorized to establish a pilot program ending no later than March 31, 2023, inclusive, to permit the keeping of hens in Wards 4, 9, 10, 11 and 19 and zones 1, 2, 3 and 4 as described in Schedule B.
- 2. This by-law shall come into force on the day it is passed.
